Wednesday 22nd November 2018

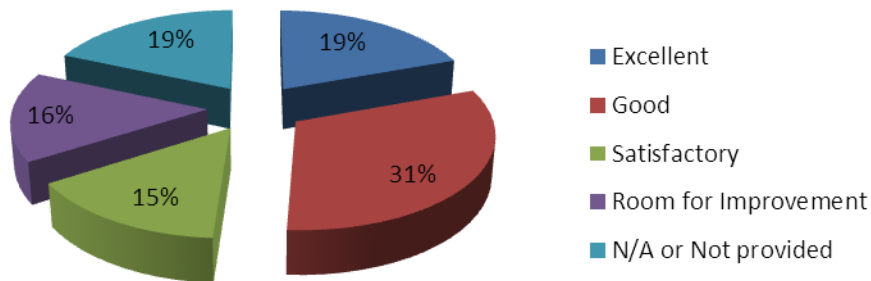

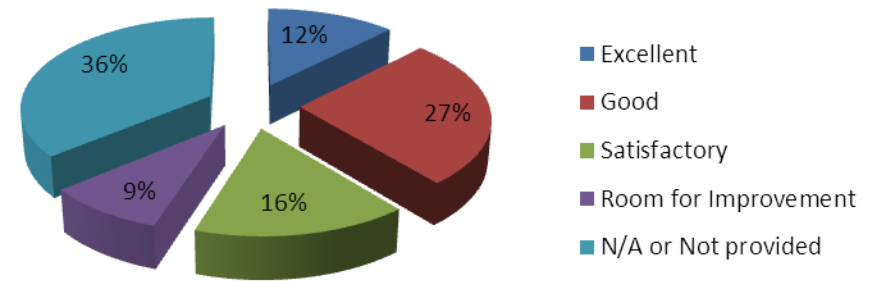
The aim of this day was to give students the experience of being interviewed by a professional employer, giving them confidence when it comes to applying and being interviewed for college courses or jobs.

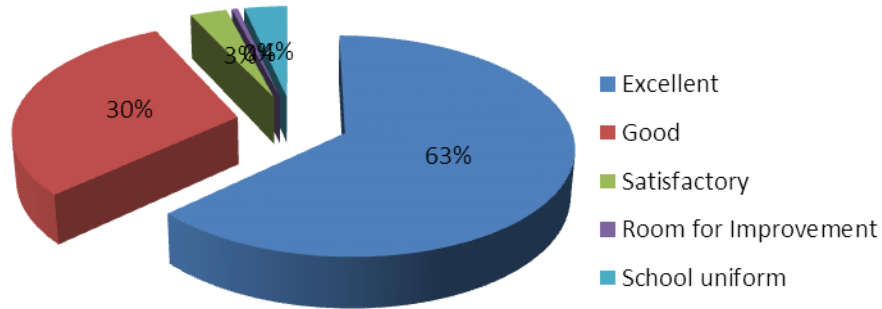

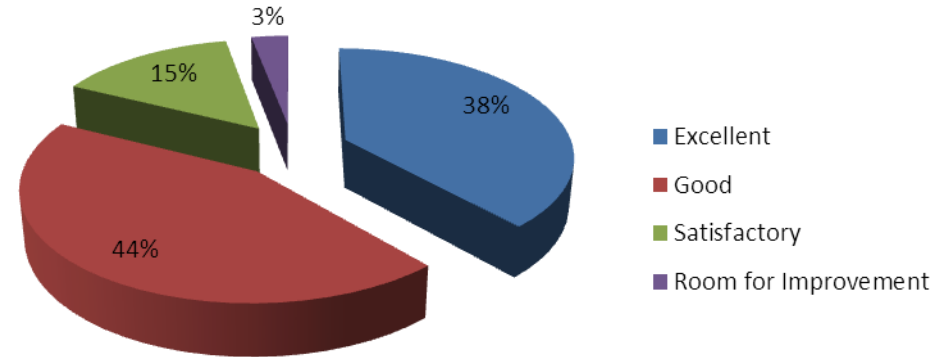

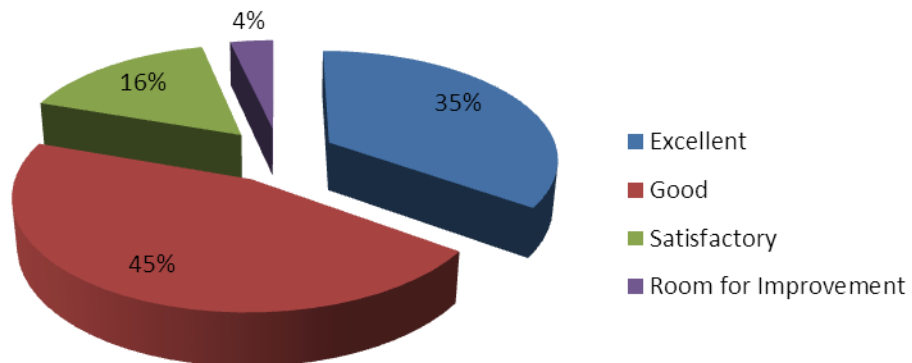

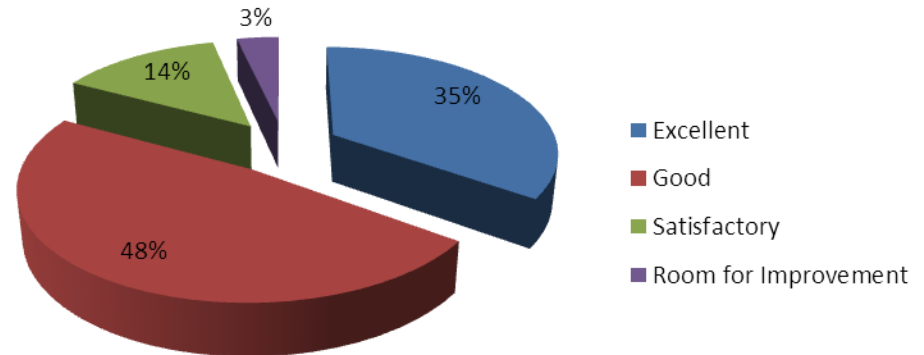

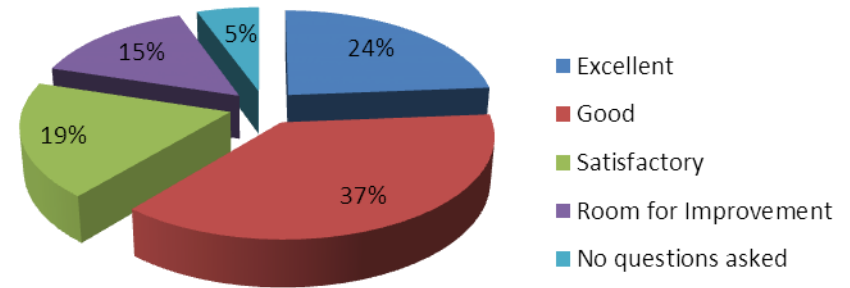

Despite a few nerves, our students really seemed to enjoy the experience

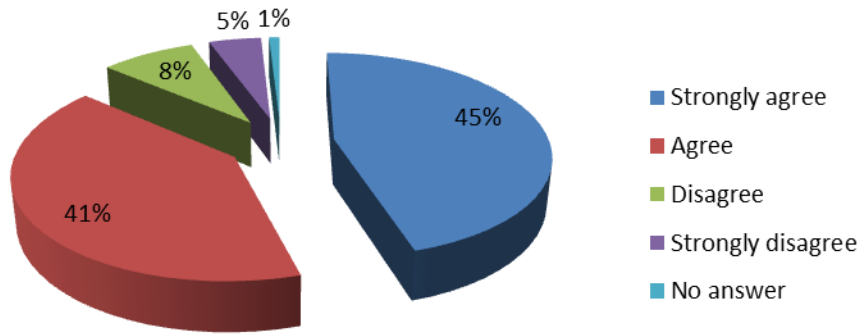

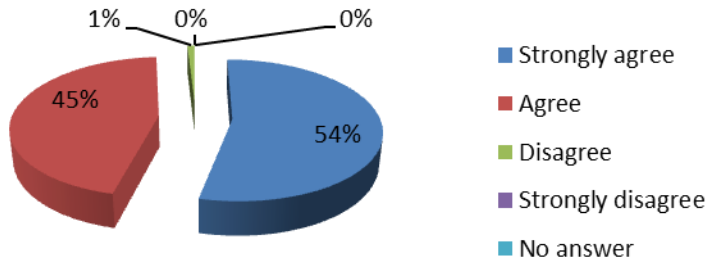
I feel that my interview was realistic and informative



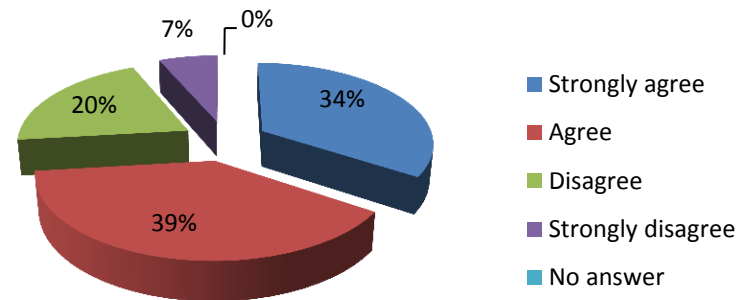
The interviewer had a professional approach
